Letter of Reference

A letter of reference (not longer than one page and signed) from a teacher, principal, counselor, or other educational professional must be submitted with the application cover sheet and essay.

Essay Topic

The student's essay should completely address the following prompt:

You have faced and overcome challenges as a second language learner.

- ✓ To what do you attribute your success in school?
- ✓ As a second language learner student, what unique contributions will you make to the community in which you'll live after you graduate college?

The essay should be typed and no more than two pages in length, double-spaced. The essay must have the student's name and high school <u>on all pages</u>. The essay must be submitted with a completed Application Cover Sheet (enclosed).

Award Process

The SCASA Scholarship Committee will read all essays received by the deadline and determine the top entries. The SCASA Executive Board will coordinate with the student's high school to present the scholarship at a school student function. The scholarship winners' award will be confirmed upon registration at a post-secondary school. The scholarship winners must report what college they will be entering in the fall, and the monetary award will be placed into their student financial account at the college to go towards tuition, registration, textbooks, and other academic expenses.
